

## JOHN GLENN REOPENING PLAN

8/12/20

**Masks must be worn at all times except when eating lunch in the classrooms.**

### Student Arrival/Dismissal

- Walkers and students being dropped off will enter the Nurses entrance (K-2) or the main entrance by the main office (3-5). Students will line up and stand on marked spots to remain 6 feet apart. Doors will open at 8:45 and students should not be dropped off prior to 8:45. Temperatures will be taken at the door.
- Bus students will be dropped off in the back of the building and enter the building at the gym entrance or back preschool door. Temperatures will be taken at the door. Students will be lined up and remain 6 feet apart.
- For Dismissal bus students will be called to the auditorium when their bus arrives. Students will stand on marked spots to remain 6 feet apart. Students will then be escorted to their bus. Masks must be worn at all times on the bus.
- **Dismissal for walkers will be staggered and walkers will exit the main door (1,2) , the front preschool entrance (3-5), Kindergarten will exit the classroom doors in the front of the building.**

### Student Schedule

- **A Cohort Monday/Thursday. B Cohort Tuesday/Friday.** All students remote on Wednesday. Remote Only is an option
- Special ed. will be in person instruction Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday. Wednesday will be remote. The classroom teacher will provide instruction on remote days.
- Related Arts limited to Music, Art & PE. 24 day cycle in place of 5 day cycle
- Technology and Library taught through classroom teacher

### Lunch

- **Students eat in the classrooms.**
- **Recess each day - staying with class in designated area**
- **Time between recess periods to sanitize equipment**

### Curriculum/Instruction

- An identified grade level remote teacher will be available on each remote day.
- Grade level teams working collaboratively with remote teacher to ensure continuity of instruction.
- Assignments and learning activities will appear in Google Classroom
- Live meetings and support available but requirements will vary by grade level.
- Attendance/participation expectations will be identified per grade level.
- Accommodations made for families who may require remote learning at different times
- Following BOE approved curriculum
- Grading will take place and there will be a final grade given
- Chromebooks will be issued to all students
